- 1. <u>Introductions/Call to Order:</u> meeting called to order by Alison Stoll at 7:03 pm. In attendance: Alison Stoll, Ronda Johnson, Terry Parker, Ted Carlston, Jo Schaefer, Barbara Strunk, Jim Howell, Lois Okrasinski. Guests: Libby Winter, Guy Benn, and Ben Sturtz.
- 2. Additions To/Approval of Agenda\*: agenda approved as written.
- 3. Hollywood Hub, Speaker Libby Winter, Community Affairs Representative, TriMet Transit Equity, Inclusion and Community Affairs: recap and updates with a slide presentation of the Hollywood Hub Project. Discussion included Libby Winter and Guy Benn with TriMet, and Ben Sturtz with Bridge Housing Corp.
- 4. <u>TriMet Better Red Line Improvement Project Update, Libby Winter:</u> improvements of the Red Line from Gateway to the Portland International Airport to begin Sep-Oct of this year. Adding a secondary track between Gateway and Portland International Airport, also adding a second transit center at Gateway and a north bound stop at Gateway Green. Will also be adding stops from Beaverton to Hillsboro. Slide presentation outlined the projects and project benefits.

\*Rose City Park, Terry Parker: slide presentation of Hollywood Hub at last meeting, discussion included pros and cons. Concerns include: what will happen to Halsey once #77 is re-routed, street parking on NE 51<sup>st,</sup> Catholic Church at NE 64<sup>th</sup> wants to be taken off Historical Designation, George Washington podium to be removed, making Alameda one-way from NE 56<sup>th</sup> & NE 57<sup>th</sup> and NE 64<sup>th</sup> & Sacramento.

\*Beaumont-Wilshire, Barbara Strunk and Jim Howell: how to manage traffic, pedestrians and bikes on NE Skidmore near Wilshire Park, speed and running signs on NE Prescott St in same area, PBOT to do a traffic study on NE Prescott St.

\*Roseway, Ted Carlston: projects on NE 72<sup>nd</sup> Sandy Blvd and NE 72<sup>nd</sup> Ave drive through on golf course into one-way traffic.

\*Grant Park, Lois Okrasinski: traffic concerns with Grant High School upper field changes, after much discussion the Grant Park Board endorsed the project.

- \*Hollywood, Jo Schaefer: three projects in Hollywood almost complete.
