- 7. Hot Topics! Neighborhoods, Other Comm & Staff:

<u>Cully, Marilee Dea and Claire Alyea:</u> DEQ coming to the Cully meeting next week to talk about clean air (see handout from Cully Air Action Team); through Federal grants sidewalks along Killingsworth from 42nd to 57th will be put in; talked about planting street trees that provide shade and also slow down vehicle traffic.

<u>Beaumont-Wilshire, Barbara Strunk:</u> talked about upcoming stair cleanup in Alameda; partnering with Grant Park for neighborhood cleanup, May 2, 2020, at Beaumont Middle School; 5 open member-at-large board positions; still raising money for Wilshire Park project; no Movie In the Park this year.

Grant Park, Ken Peterson: talked about changes to Grant High School field and bowl.

<u>Hollywood</u>, <u>Jo Schaefer</u>: talked about a recent meeting regarding the Street Car proposed from Montgomery Park to the Hollywood District; a Federal Grant (along with Parkrose Neighborhood Association) to conduct a Police Department Public Safety survey, chose 6 top priorities to work on first, response for survey was 59 pages long, grant funds will include costs of printing and swag items for promotion.

<u>Madison South, Doug Fasching:</u> next meeting March 5, 2020; Movie In The Park is August 1, 2020 at Glenhaven Park; talked about Rocky Butte Farmers Market; talked about the homeless.

Roseway, Catherine Wilson: partner with Madison South for their Neighborhood cleanup on May 23, 2020; talked about business additions in Roseway; meetings will now be held at Roseway Heights School.
