<u>Sumner, Karen McAninch:</u> held elections at last general meeting on April 17, 2018, added Donna Moir as a member-at-large, remainder of the board is the same.

Beaumont-Wilshire, Kathy Campbell and Barbara Strunk: gave update on A Taste of Beaumont held April 9, 2018, the event was very successful with 17 restaurants and businesses participating; one new board member and one member that resigned, so there are still 2 openings on the board; upcoming Spring Walking Tour of 19 properties will be held Saturday, May 19, 2018 from 10am to noon, cost is \$5; Saturday, May 12, 2018 is the Pollinator Workshop from 9am to 11:30 am at CNN and you must register with East Multnomah Soil & Water Conversation District.
